We have some exciting news to share with you all! In 2025, [buycycle](#), the leading marketplace for premium, pre-owned bikes and bike parts, is partnering with [Project Echelon](#) to help two veterans within the Project Echelon community start their cycling season with new-to-them bikes or components!

The partnership will support Project Echelon's mission by enabling veterans to access buycycle's inventory of 30,000 premium pre-owned bikes and equipment, allowing grantees to upgrade their cycling equipment. Any (and we mean it! ANY!) veteran who is a part of the Project Echelon Community will be eligible to apply and two grantees will be awarded \$1,000 grants.

How to apply:

Step 1: Become a member of The Project Echelon Community

In order to be eligible for a grant, **you must be a member of the Project Echelon Community**. Before applying, please fill out the [Project Echelon Interest Form](#) to become a member of the Project Echelon Community and complete your onboarding. If you are already a member, great! You do not need to fill out the form again if you have already gone through the onboarding process.

Step 2: Apply for our grant through our website!

Please visit the Project Echelon webpage at www.projectechelon.org, [Link to google survey stipend application](#)] and fill out the application questionnaire as fully as you can. We encourage you to tell us as much as you are comfortable with so we can best get to know you during the review process of application.

Step 3: Review Process and Grantee Announcements

Every application will be read and reviewed by the Project Echelon Board of Directors, who will adhere to the following timeline as best as possibly during the application process, unless otherwise noted:

- Monday March 31st: Application opens
- Monday April 14th 11:59:59pm CST: Application closes
- Monday April 21st: Individual recipients announced
